FRSS Note: The FY08 omnibus bill allocated \$2.16 million for an Arts in Education in Public Elementary and Secondary Schools survey during the 2009-10 school year using the Fast Response Survey System, to be administered by the National Center for Education Statistics. Supplemental FRSS funds were also provided by the USED.

FY09 Note: The omnibus bill language does not explain the intended expenditure of \$80,000 of total appropriated funds.

FY11 Note: Congressional language accompanying the FY11 Continuing Resolution recommended \$25.5 million for the Arts in Education funding program. Under its discretion, the USED allocated \$27.5 million.
