- Gain access to educational events and activities such as B# Luncheons, a book club, and informative lectures with musicians, guest artists, composers, and Symphony staff.



- Membership increased 32%
- 94% of current members renewed a 12% increase
- Membership revenue was a League record \$40,350 an increase of \$9,850
- More potential volunteers, donors, and Symphony ticket holders

We learned some valuable lessons on how to sustainably grow our membership

- Gather all data to assess what worked and what didn't
- Experiment with new strategies and measure how well they work
- From those learnings, build new pathways and new processes to recruit and retain members and continue to Focus on What Works
