Rebecca Cain joined the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra as Vice President of Orchestra Operations in fall 2022, becoming VP of Operations in 2024. Rebecca began her career as the second bassoonist in the Tucson Symphony Orchestra after receiving dual degrees from Oberlin College and Conservatory and an MM from Arizona State University. Prior to joining the Pittsburgh Symphony staff, Rebecca held a variety of roles at orchestra around the country, including Vice President of Operations at the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra, Director of Production at the Louisiana Philharmonic in New Orleans, and numerous roles at the Tucson Symphony Orchestra.
